ORDINANCE No. 23-04 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OBERLIN COMMUNITY SERVICES COUNCIL AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE.

WHEREAS, Oberlin Community Services Council (“OCS”) is an Oberlin-based 501(c)(3) corporation that provides a variety of support services to the residents of the City of Oberlin; and

WHEREAS, the Oberlin City Council desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into a services contract with OCS and to provide funding to enable OCS to continue to provide important support services to the residents of the City of Oberlin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council does hereby authorize and direct the City Manager to enter into a contract with Oberlin Community Services Council, for a term of three (3) years for the provision of services to the residents of the City of Oberlin in substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to assure the continuation of important support services to Oberlin City Residents, and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
