**ORDINANCE No. 23-61 AC CMS**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 23-44 TO AUTHORIZE A CHANGE ORDER WITH THE CHARTER MACHINE COMPANY OF METUCHEN, NEW JERSEY FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE CHARTER MACHINE COMPANY BELT FILTER PRESS MODEL 17.43S FOR THE WATER ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION FACILITY AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 23-44 AC CMS, the City Council of the City of Oberlin authorized the purchase of a Charter Machine Company Belt Filter Press Model 17.43S with Electrical Control Panel, 10” Screw Conveyor, Washwater Booster Pump and related equipment from the Charter Machine Company of Metuchen, New Jersey for the City of Oberlin Public Works Department for the not-to-exceed price of \$342,900.00; and,

WHEREAS, in reviewing manufacturer equipment submittals, the City of Oberlin Water Environment Protection Facility has determined that it is in the City’s best interest to upgrade the hot dip galvanized perforated roller to a 316 stainless steel perforated roller.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to accept the change order with the Charter Machine Company of Metuchen, New Jersey to upgrade the perforated roller to 316 stainless steel on the Charter Machine Company Belt Filter Press Model 17.43S for the additional cost of \$14,879.00 and to establish a new not-to-exceed price of \$357,779.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to accept the equipment upgrade for the Charter Belt Filter Press in a timely fashion and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.


