City of Oberlin Water Division Working to Resolve Drinking Water Issue

OBERLIN, OHIO – (September 22, 2023) – The City of Oberlin Water Division is aware of an unusual taste and odor in Oberlin’s drinking water. As a result, Water Division staff are testing additional samples to determine the cause of this issue. The City is following our water treatment plan, as well as working with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) and our consulting engineer throughout this process.

Several water treatment adjustments have been made within the last week in response to the concerns, and as water may take up to a week to work its way through the City’s distribution system, the Water Division is actively flushing water mains to move water throughout the community.

More information will be provided regarding the results of testing and any further treatment plans. The City appreciates the Oberlin community’s patience as we work to resolve this issue.
