ORDINANCE No. 23-65 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1501.25 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, ESTABLISHING REQUIRED PERMITS AND FEES FOR SERVICES OF THE OBERLIN FIRE DEPARTMENT AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 1501.25, Part (g) of the Codified Ordinances be and is hereby amended to read as is set forth in **Exhibit A** attached hereto.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: **to provide for the efficient operation of the Oberlin City Fire Department**, and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
