A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE FOR THE LORAIN COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin is located within the Lorain County Solid Waste Management District; and

WHEREAS, the Lorain County Solid Waste Management Policy Committee prepared and adopted a final draft of the Solid Waste Management Plan in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 3734.53, 3734.54 and 3734.55; and

WHEREAS, the Lorain County Solid Waste Management District has provided a copy of the 2024-2033 Draft Solid Waste Management Plan Update dated July 11, 2023 for ratification to each of the legislative authorities of the District; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Oberlin City Council hereby approves the 2024-2033 Draft Solid Waste Management Plan Update.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to send a copy of this resolution to the attention of Victoria Kish, Administrative Assistant, Lorain County Solid Waste Management District, 226 Middle Avenue, 5th Floor, Elyria, OH 44035 or to vkish@loraincounty.us.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to allow for the submission of said resolution to the Lorain County Solid Waste Management District within the ninety day approval period and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
