ORDINANCE No. 24-27 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING JON D. CLARK AS THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That pursuant to Section V(C) of the Oberlin City Charter, Jon D. Clark, the City of Oberlin Law Director, be and is hereby appointed as Interim City Manager of the City of Oberlin, Ohio to serve for a term beginning on May 9, 2024 until such time as the appointment of a City Manager by the Oberlin City Council becomes effective.

SECTION 2: That service as the Interim City Manager shall be in addition to that of the City Law Director. The compensation to be paid for service as the Interim City Manager shall be determined by further legislation. Such compensation shall be in addition to the amounts and benefits set forth in Ordinance No. 13-13 AC CMS, appointing the City Law Director, as amended.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: To ensure the continuous and orderly operation of the day-to-day activities of the City and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
