## RESOLUTION No. R25-01 CMS

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R24-07 CMS DESIGNATING CITY OFFICIAL(S) WHO ARE AUTHORIZED TO ESTABLISH ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS FROM LORAIN COUNTY FOR VARIOUS PROPERTY TAX SETTLEMENT PAYMENTS AND OTHER PAYMENTS TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, Pursuant to resolution number R24-07 CMS, certain City officials were authorized to establish ACH/electronic payment instructions with the City's banking information for the Lorain County Auditor and Treasurer, and,

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R24-07 CMS designated then Finance Director Beth A. Krosse, and Treasurer Belinda Anderson, as being the City officials authorized to establish said ACH/electronic payments, and

WHEREAS, Finance Director Beth Krosse has since resigned from the City of Oberlin, and

WHEREAS, Marin Fowler has been appointed by the City Council to be interim Finance Director for the City of Oberlin and Belinda Anderson remains the Treasurer for the City of Oberlin, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to designate the City officials who may establish electronic payments from Lorain County as initially authorized under Resolution No. R24-07 CMS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Section 1 of Resolution R24-07 be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1: That Marin Fowler, the interim Finance Director for the City of Oberlin, and Belinda Anderson, Treasurer for the City of Oberlin, be and are hereby authorized to establish ACH/electronic payment instructions with the City's banking information for the Lorain County Auditor and Treasurer so the City of Oberlin may receive property tax settlement payments and other payments electronically from Lorain County.


SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: To ensure that property tax payments and other payments are received timely from Lorain County and provided that at least five (5) members of Council

determine by motion, this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
