ORDINANCE No. 25-10 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY EXISTS IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF KLEYNE MOBILE REPAIR, LLC FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF A TRANSMISSION IN A CITY REFUSE AND RECYCLING TRUCK TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin Public Works Department General Maintenance Division purchased three Autocar refuse/recycling vehicles in 2014 equipped with Parker Hannifin's proprietary hybrid hydraulic drive system; and,

WHEREAS, Parker Hannifin is no longer manufacturing the hybrid hydraulic drive system or supporting repair and replacement of its constituent parts; and,

WHEREAS, two of the Autocar refuse/recycling vehicles are not currently in service due to hybrid hydraulic drive system issues that cannot be repaired; and,

WHEREAS, Kleyne Mobile Repair, LLC has successfully developed a conversion process to replace Parker Hannifin's proprietary hybrid hydraulic drive system with a conventional automatic transmission; and,

WHEREAS, the 2015 Autocar Expedito chassis equipped with the Heil Multipack Body has low operating hours and its chassis and work body are otherwise in good condition for continued service; and,

WHEREAS, the reliable operation of the City's refuse and recycling collection vehicles is a critical component of service to the City's customers and rate payers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That under the provisions of Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code it is hereby declared and determined that a real and present emergency exists in the City of Oberlin Municipal Public Works Department due to the need to replace the failed hybrid hydraulic transmission in the 2015 Autocar Expedito chassis equipped with the Heil Multipack Body as soon as possible thereby requiring immediate authority for the City Manager to accept the proposal of Kleyne Mobile Repair, LLC without advertisement or competitive bidding for the replacement of the failed hybrid hydraulic drive transmission with a conventional automatic transmission.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to accept the proposal of Kleyne Mobile Repair, LLC of Jenison, Michigan for the replacement of the failed transmission with a conventional automatic transmission for the not-to-exceed price of \$90,250.37, which price includes a 10% contingency.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. To provide for the timely replacement of the failed hybrid hydraulic drive system in order to ensure reliable refuse and recycling collection services to the City's customers and rate payers and provided that at least five (5) members of the Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
