## ORDINANCE No. 25-26 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH GPD GROUP OF AKRON, OHIO, FOR BID ASSISTANCE AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 21-59 AC CMS Oberlin City Council authorized a contract with GPD Group of Akron, Ohio for professional services for design, bid assistance and construction administration for two traffic signals at the Lorain and Park Street intersection in the amount of \$79,750, ("Professional Services Contract"); and

WHEREAS, during the work, it was determined to widen the Lorain and Park Street intersection requiring additional professional services in the amount of \$8,200.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Professional Services Contract, an amendment is proposed to accommodate the cost of additional services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the proposed Amendment to the Engineering Design Services contract between the City of Oberlin and GPD Group, Ohio, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, for additional professional engineering in an additional amount not to exceed \$8,200.00

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. To facilitate the Traffic Signal bidding and construction assistance and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
