ORDINANCE No. 25-28 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 24-56, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DISTRICT 9 PUBLIC WORKS INTEGRATING COMMITTEE FOR OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FUNDING FOR THE PARK AND EAST VINE STREETS RESURFACING PROJECT TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 24-56 City Council authorized the City Manager to submit an application to the District 9 Public Works Integrating Committee for Ohio Public Works Commission Funding for the Park and East Vine Streets Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission requires specific legislative authorization for the City Manager and Finance Director to execute contracts and other documents for the Park and East Vine Streets Resurfacing Project if the OPWC Round 39 funding application is approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance 24-56 authorizing the City's OPWC application for the Park and East Vine Streets Resurfacing Project is hereby amended to read as follows:

That the City Manager and the Finance Director are hereby authorized to enter into any agreements with the Ohio Public Works Commission as may be necessary and appropriate to obtain financial assistance for said OPWC Round 39 funding if the application is approved.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. To ensure that the City of Oberlin authorizing legislation for the City's Park and East Vine Streets Resurfacing Project meets Ohio Public Works Commission requirements in a timely fashion so as not to delay project funding and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
