ORDINANCE No. 25-32 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH GPD GROUP OF AKRON, OHIO, FOR THE ENGINEERING, BID ASSISTANCE, AND CONSTRUCTION OBSERVATION FOR A NEW SUBSTATION AND 69KV TRANSMISSION LINE EXTENSION TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 23-39 AC CMS, the Oberlin City Council authorized a contract with GPD Group of Akron, Ohio, for Engineering, Bid Assistance and Construction Observation for a new Substation and 69kv Transmission Line Extension in the amount of \$732,550 (“Professional Services Contract”); and

WHEREAS, during the work, it was determined that changing the route of the new transmission line and replacing some older and /or difficult-to-access transmission line sections would be beneficial, requiring additional professional services.

WHEREAS, a change order is required to authorize the cost of additional Professional Services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Subject to the lawful appropriation of funds the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute an amendment to the Engineering, Bid Assistance, and Construction Observation for a new Substation and 69kv Transmission Line Extension contract between the City of Oberlin and GPD Group, Ohio, in substantially the form attached hereto in an amount not to exceed \$122,470.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. To facilitate the Engineering, Bid Assistance and Construction Observation for a new Substation and 69kv Transmission Line Extension and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.


