ORDINANCE No. 25-33 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH GPD GROUP OF AKRON, OHIO, FOR THE ENGINEERING SERVICES PROPOSAL FOR POWER PLANT GENERATOR 7 & 8 RELAY PROTECTION AND VOLTAGE REGULATOR UPGRADE PROJECT TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, in November 2024, the City of Oberlin entered into a contract with GPD Group of Akron, Ohio, for the Power Plant Generators 7 & 8 Relay Protection and Voltage Regulator Upgrade Project in the amount of \$72,400 ("Professional Services Contract"); and

WHEREAS, after the making of the Professional Services Contract, it was determined that the increase in the scope of necessary services initially anticipated to complete the project necessitates an amendment to the Professional Services Contract.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Subject to the lawful appropriation of funds that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute an Amendment to the Power Plant Generators 7 & 8 Relay Protection and Voltage Regulator Upgrade Project contract between the City of Oberlin and GPD Group in substantially the form attached hereto for additional professional engineering services in an amount not-to-exceed \$42,400 for a total project cost of \$114,800.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. To facilitate the Power Plant Generators 7 & 8 Relay Protection and Voltage Regulator Upgrade Project and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
