ORDINANCE No. 25-35 AC MS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FIRST TRANSIT, INC. TO PROVIDE FOR TRANSIT-RELATED SERVICES TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That an agreement between the City of Oberlin and First Transit Inc., a Delaware Limited Liability Company to provide transit-related services for a 2-year period beginning August 1, 2025, in substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A** is hereby approved, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute same on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. To authorize an agreement to continue local public transit fixed route service for two (2) years and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
