A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A PORTION OF THE 2ND FLOOR OF 69 SOUTH MAIN STREET AS OFFICE SPACE FOR THE CITY MANAGER TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, Chapter 104 of the Oberlin Codified Ordinances provides in part that Council shall, by resolution, provide for the future assignment of spaces in the City Hall and other buildings owned by the City for its own use and for the use and occupancy of Council appointees and their staff; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to designate office space for the City Manager and their staff.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That a portion of the 2^{nd} floor of 69 South Main Street is hereby designated as office space for the City Manager and their staff.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. To facilitate the renovation of office spaces for the City Manager, and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
