AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DISTRICT 9 PUBLIC WORKS INTEGRATING COMMITTEE FOR OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION FUNDING FOR THE INDUSTRIAL PARK STREETS RESURFACING PROJECT TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and file an application with the District 9 Public Works Integrating Committee for Ohio Public Works Commission Round 40 funding for Industrial Park Streets Resurfacing Project.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager and the Finance Director are hereby authorized to enter into any agreements with the Ohio Public Works Commission as may be necessary and appropriate to obtain financial assistance for said OPWC Round 40 funding if the application is approved.

SECTION 3. That the City of Oberlin hereby agrees that if said OPWC Round 40 project is funded, the City of Oberlin will provide local matching funds as designated in the application.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. To submit an application for funding within applicable time limits, and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
