A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE PROCEDURAL RULES RELATING TO THE MEETINGS OF OBERLIN CITY COUNCIL TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, Council has established certain procedural and substantive rules, (“Rules”), relating to the conduct and content if its meetings; and,

WHEREAS, Council desires to update and amend its Rules.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Procedural Rules Relating to the Meetings of the Oberlin City Council be and are hereby amended as is set forth in **Exhibit A**:

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees were made in accordance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. To facilitate the efficient conduct of the meetings of the Oberlin City Council, and provided that at least five (5) members of its members determine by motion, this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
