RESOLUTION No. R26-01 CMS

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING JESSA NEW AS THE DESIGNEE OF THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS LAW TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, Ohio Law requires elected officials to undergo educational training for every term of office related to the requirements of the public records law, Ohio Revised Code Section 149.43; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 109.43 provides that the elected officials of a public office may appoint a "Designee" to undergo such training on their behalf; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that Jessa New Council Member of Oberlin City Council should serve as the legal "Designee" of the members of Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Jessa New is hereby appointed the "Designee" within the meaning set forth in Ohio Revised Code Section 109.43.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. To ensure the timely appointment of a designee for members of Council to meet the deadline for Ohio Sunshine Law Certification Training as soon as possible and provided that at least five (5) members determine by motion that this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
