ORDINANCE NO. 26-11 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN STRUCTUREPOINT, INC. OF CLEVELAND, OHIO, TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE EAST VINE STREET BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 23-51 AC CMS, Oberlin City Council authorized an Engineering Services Contract with American Structurepoint, Inc. of Cleveland, Ohio for professional engineering services for the replacement of the East Vine Street Bridge in the City of Oberlin in an amount not-to-exceed \$270,438; and

WHEREAS, during the course of bridge design, it was determined that the preferred replacement structure is a single span composite box beam bridge rather than a 3-sided box culvert; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 24-07, Oberlin City Council authorized an amendment to said Engineering Services Contract in the not-to-exceed amount of \$86,003.00 to provide additional funding to design the single span composite box beam bridge; and

WHEREAS, during the construction of said bridge it became apparent that the existing sanitary sewer could not be re-connected as-is without significant additional changes to the bridge structure plans; and

WHEREAS, American Structurepoint, Inc. evaluated alternatives and provided additional professional engineering design services to relocate the existing sanitary sewer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the proposed Amendment to the Engineering Design Services contract between the City of Oberlin and American Structurepoint, Inc. of Cleveland, Ohio dated January 19, 2026 and attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, for additional professional engineering services necessary for the replacement of the East Vine Street Bridge in the City of Oberlin in an additional amount not-to-exceed \$5,500.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. To provide funding for necessary additional engineering services for the replacement of the East Vine Street Bridge in the City of Oberlin, and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
