ORDINANCE NO. 26-36 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BEST EQUIPMENT COMPANY, INC. OF INDIANAPOLIS, INDIANA, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A COMMERCIAL REAR-LOAD REFUSE COLLECTION VEHICLE TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1. That pursuant to the authority granted under Ohio Revised Code Section 9.48(C), the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Best Equipment Company, Inc. of Indianapolis, Indiana, through Sourcewell Contract #110223 for the purchase of a 2026 Autocar ACX-64 chassis equipped with a Leach 2R-III Rear-Load Packer Body for the City of Oberlin Public Works Department for the purchase price of \$391,000.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



To authorize the purchase of a commercial rear-load refuse collection vehicle without delay, and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
