**ORDINANCE No. 26-45 AC CMS**

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF UNDERGROUND UTILITIES, INC. OF MONROEVILLE, OHIO FOR THE FOREST STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Underground Utilities, Inc. of Monroeville, Ohio for the Forest Street Improvement Project, being the lowest and best bid received, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being in the amount of \$1,948,784.70.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. To accept a bid within the time limitations provided by law and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
