ORDINANCE NO. 26-50 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH OPENGOV, INC THROUGH VERTOSOFT OF LEESBURG, VIRGINIA, FOR THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT SERVICES TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the authority granted under Ohio Revised Code Section 9.48(C), the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with OpenGov, Inc. through Vertosoft of Leesburg, Virginia, Sourcewell Contract # 060624-VTO for the provision of professional financial management services, including general ledger accounts payable, accounts receivables, requisitions, cash receipts, bank reconciliation, accounts receivable, purchase cards, fixed assets, budgeting & performance, financial reporting and related services for a price of \$1,175,888.86 substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code

SECTION 3. To facilitate the upgrade of financial management systems for the City of Oberlin and thereby promote the efficient operation of the Finance Department, and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
