RESOLUTION No. R26-07 CMS

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R25-01 CMS DESIGNATING CITY OFFICIALS WHO ARE AUTHORIZED TO ESTABLISH ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS FROM LORAIN COUNTY FOR PROPERTY TAX SETTLEMENT AND OTHER PAYMENTS TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R25-01 CMS, certain City officials were authorized to establish ACH/electronic payment instructions with the City's banking information for the Lorain County Auditor and Treasurer, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R25-01 CMS designated the then Interim Finance Director, Marin Fowler, and Treasurer Belinda Anderson, as being the City officials authorized to establish said ACH/electronic payments, and

WHEREAS, since the passage of Resolution No. R25-01, Council has appointed Marin Fowler as the City Finance Director and Greg Holcomb as the City Treasurer, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Resolution No. R25-01 to designate the current City officials who may establish electronic payments from Lorain County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Section 1 of Resolution No. 25-01 CMS be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1: That Marin Fowler, the City Finance Director, and Greg Holcomb, the City Treasurer, are hereby authorized to establish ACH/electronic payment instructions for the Lorain County Auditor and Treasurer for the City of Oberlin to receive property tax settlement and other payments from Lorain County.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



To ensure that property tax payments and other payments are received timely from Lorain County and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.


