ORDINANCE NO. 26-57 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN EXTENSION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE LORAIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO PROVIDE FOR TRANSIT- RELATED SERVICES TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the previously approved agreement between the City of Oberlin and the Lorain County Commissioners to provide for transit-related services between July 1, 2024 and June 30, 2026, a copy being attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby extended to June 30, 2027, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said extension on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

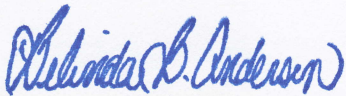
SECTION 3. To authorize an extension of an agreement in order for Lorain County to continue providing federal transit funding (50% of total costs) to support the EBus fixed route public transit service for an additional year and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
