ORDINANCE NO. 26-64 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED TO GO INTO IMMEDIATE EFFECT

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin is planning to make capital improvements for the West Hamilton Street Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the West Hamilton Street Improvement Project is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and file an application with the District 9 Public Works Integrating Committee for Ohio Public Works Commission Round 41 funding for the West Hamilton Street Improvement Project.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager and the Finance Director are hereby authorized to enter into any agreements with the Ohio Public Works Commission as may be necessary and appropriate to obtain financial assistance for said OPWC Round 41 funding if the application is approved.

SECTION 3. That the City of Oberlin hereby agrees that if said OPWC Round 41 project is funded, the City of Oberlin will provide local matching funds as designated in the application.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. To facilitate access to funding for the West Hamilton Street Improvement Project and provided that at least five (5) members of Council determine by

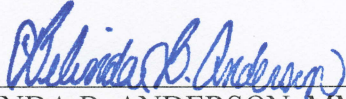
motion, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

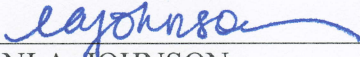
